Why is my BCM not working?

3. No Communication with Scan Tool When a technician or DIYer attempts to communicate with the BCM using a scan tool or code reader, they may find that there is no communication. This indicates the BCM has lost connection with the vehicle's controller area network (CAN) and is not sending or receiving data.

What does a bad BCM code indicate?

The code, depending on the year, make and model of the vehicle, may indicate that the BC Body Control Module (BCM) is bad, not receiving or sending a signal, the BCM harness has an open or short, or that the BCM is not communicating with the Engine Control Module (ECM) via the controller area network - the CAN communication line. The BCM plays a crucial role in managing various vehicle functions like power windows, power seats, and climate control.

Should I replace my BCM?

Replacing the BCM requires special tools and programming equipment to ensure the new module communicates properly with the vehicle's other systems. Attempting to replace the BCM yourself could result in further damage and costly repairs.<> Preventing BCM issues starts with proper maintenance of your vehicle's electrical system.

How do I Reset my BCM?

Using your scan tool, navigate to the BCM menu. The exact menu location will vary by scan tool, but it is usually located under the "Body" or "Module Setup" menu. Once in the BCM menu, look for an option labeled "Reset," "Relearn," or "Recalibrate." Select this option and follow the on-screen prompts to perform the reset.
