Do I need a travel adapter for a Ghana Charger?

However, it is possible you'll need an adapter to plug the charger into a Ghana outlet. Ghana uses electrical outlets and power plugs of types D & G (see images). If your country uses the same electrical outlets and power plugs, you don't need a travel adapter. Are the electrical outlets and power plugs in your country different?
